CHILD CARE SUBSIDY






HEALTHY HABIT TIP OF THE MONTH

WHAT IS NC PRE-K?



NC Pre-K is a free educational program designed to prepare eligible children for a successful entrance to Kindergarten. Utilizing a play based curriculum, NC Pre-K facilitates developmentally appropriate learning for children that focuses on both cognitive and social/emotional development. Students who participate will be provided with a 6.5 hour day, which follows the public school calendar. Families who are interested in applying are encouraged to review the eligibility requirements listed below.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

*Children who are age 4 by August 31, 2023 and meet income eligibility requirements based on family size.

*Children who are not income eligible, may still be able to participate, if one of the following criteria is met:

- Developmental Delay with documentation
- IEP
- English as a Second Language
- Active Duty Military / Disabled Veteran
- Chronic Health Condition

WHAT IS REQUIRED TO APPLY?

- Copy of Child's Birth Certificate
- Proof of Residency (Actively Living in Harnett County)
- Proof of Regular Gross Income for the household
- Proof of Active Duty Status / VA Disability (Military Families only)
- Copy of child's IEP (if applicable)
- Copy of diagnosis or therapies as a result of a developmental delay

READY TO GROW



Ready to Grow Playgroup facilitates developmentally appropriate playgroups for children and caregivers who reside in Harnett County. Eligible children must be between the ages of birth through 5 years old. Playgroup facilitators use Kaleidoscope Play & Learn Curriculum to provide hands on activities that focus on early literacy and social emotional competency. Caregivers learn about the purpose of play and will connect with other parents during group time. Children and caregivers will participate in coordinated group activities to prepare the children for success in school.

READY TO GROW PLAYGROUP

THEME OF THE MONTH: Let's Learn to Measure!



KEY MESSAGE

- 1. Important math concepts, such as measuring and the ability to describe the properties of an item are learned at an early age in the context of play.

 2. Children are natural experimenters, so helping guide that curiosity (by providing tools and the language to match it) will help children develop important math skills.
- 3. We can find opportunities throughout the day to work on these skills. Involving children in cooking projects can teach children how to measure ingredients. Having cups in the bathtub allows children to understand volume by experimenting with how much water can fit in the big cup vs. the small cup.
- 4. Learning how to use measuring tools and describing properties such as size, weight, and shape are important pre-academic skills that children will need in order to be successful when they enter school.

MENSAJES CLAVE:

- 1. Los conceptos matemáticos importantes, como medir y la capacidad de describir las propiedades de un elemento, se aprenden a una edad temprana por medio del juego.
- 2. Los niños son experimentadores naturales, por lo que ayudar a guiar esa curiosidad (proporcionando herramientas y el lenguaje para que coincida) ayudará a los niños a desarrollar habilidades matemáticas importantes.
- 3. Podemos encontrar oportunidades a lo largo del día para trabajar en estas habilidades. Involucrar a los niños en proyectos de cocina puede enseñarles cómo medir los ingredientes. Tener tazas/vasos en la bañera permite a los niños entender el volumen experimentando con cuánta agua puede caber en la taza/vaso grande frente a la taza/vaso pequeña.


