

HEALTHY HABIT TIP OF THE MONTH - CAN YOUNG CHILDREN EAT FISH?


Infants 6 months and older can eat 1 to 2 servings a week of a variety of fish that are lower in mercury. The serving size is 1 ounce. Options for fish that are low in mercury: canned light tuna, catfish (farm-raised), pollock, salmon, shad, tilapia, whitefish, and whiting.

If you have questions about fish choices for your child, talk with your pediatrician. A FEW KEY NOTES FROM THE HARNETT COUNTY NC PRE-K STAFF:

- Applications need to be in before June 30th for the first round of placements!
- Once your application has been received you will get a letter via mail around July 15th regardingt placement into the NC Pre-K program.
- We have started the screening process for Harnett County. Be on the lookout for an email from NC Pre-K for screening dates. If you receive the email, please do not share it with friends. We are strategically inviting children to sign up and will eventually get to all our applicants.



Applications submitted by June 30th will be considered for the first round of placements.



Ready to Grow Playgroup facilitates developmentally appropriate playgroups for children and caregivers who reside in Harnett County. Eligible children must be between the ages of birth through 5 years old. Playgroup facilitators use Kaleidoscope Play & Learn Curriculum to provide hands on activities that focus on early literacy and social emotional competency. Caregivers learn about the purpose of play and will connect with other parents during group time. Children and caregivers will participate in coordinated group activities to prepare the children for success in school.

<u>Lillington Playgroup</u> meets on Mondays at 10:30am-12pm at 170 Pine State St, Lillington.



MENSAJES CLAVE:

- 1. A medida que los niños se desarrollan, comienzan a tener un mejor sentido de sí mismos, que son personas individuales separadas de sus padres, cuidadores y otros.




FISH OR INSECTS- CATCH THE FISH BY CIRCLING THEM BELOW.
