READY TO GROW GRUPO DE JUEGOS LISTO PARA CRECER

Ready to Grow Playgroup facilitates developmentally appropriate playgroups for children and caregivers who reside in Harnett County. Eligible children must be between the ages of birth through 5 years old. Playgroup facilitators use Kaleidoscope Play & Learn Curriculum to provide hands on activities that focus on early literacy and social emotional competency. Caregivers learn about the purpose of play and will connect with other parents during group time. Children and caregivers will participate in coordinated group activities to prepare the children for success in school.

GRUPO DE JUEGOS LISTO PARA CRECER

TEMA DEL MES:

1, 2, 3: Aprendiendo Números

LOS CUIDADORES APRENDERÁN:

- Cómo ayudar a su hijo a contar del 1 al 20
- Cómo ayudar a su hijo a contar de 10 a 20 objetos (señalando cada uno)
- Cómo ayudar a su hijo a identificar los números que corresponden al 1-10

MENSAJES CLAVE:

- 1. Aprender a contar, reconocer números, entender la cantidad y cómo ordenar elementos son habilidades matemáticas fundamentales vitales. Para aprender conceptos matemáticos más complejos, los niños deben primero comprender estos conceptos numéricos básicos.
- 2. Podemos ayudar a los niños a aprender a reconocer los números escritos señalándolos durante el día (por ejemplo, "La etiqueta de tu camisa dice: 'Tamaño 4'. Mira, eso es '4'.

READY TO GROW PLAYGROUP

THEME OF THE MONTH:

1, 2, 3: Learning Numbers

2 3

CAREGIVERS WILL LEARN:

- How to help their child count from 1-20
- How to help their child count 10-20 objects (pointing to each one)
- How to help their child identify the numbers 1-10

KEY MESSAGES:

- 1. Learning to count, recognize numbers, understand quantity, and how to order items are vital foundational math skills. To learn more complex math concepts, children must first grasp these basic number concepts.
- 2. We can help children learn to recognize written numbers by pointing out written numbers to them throughout the day (e.g., "The tag on your shirt says, "Size 4." See, that's "4."
