Services for People with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities

Cover 7 counties Cumberland, Durham, Harnett, Johnston, Orange, Mecklenburg and Wake

Serve over 190,000 people that have Medicaid or tailored plan

How IDD affects daily life-physical, intellectual or emotional development

Cover long term services

Care Management helps you find the resources you need.

1915i services- varies by benefit basis- have to have a certain % of a deficit to qualify

The Innovations Waiver- allows people to get services in their own home or community to live as independently as possible

There is a long waitlist for the Innovations waiver wait list

IDD services

Respite care, supported employment and Community Living support

Traumatic Brain Injury Waiver- happens on or after their 18th birthday

High Fidelity Wraparound- 3- 21 years old

The families are struggling with mental health, education, and feel hopeless and support youth as early as possible.

Evidence based model and structured model and follows 10 principles

Lean on Natural Supports

The Team= Coach, Facilitator, Family Support Partner, Youth Support Partner

Meet once a week incorporate what they need in the process.

The Four Phases of HFW

Medicaid Direct covers this program

Have to have mental health diagnosis and is more behavioral in nature
